Supportive Services for Veteran Families [SSVF]

Sixth largest program in the USA provides veterans (and their families) who are experiencing a housing crisis either prevention or rehousing services. Services provided in Pinellas, Pasco, Hillsborough, and Polk counties.



Returning Home

Returning Home provides supportive services and rental assistance to individuals and families staying in emergency shelters or on the street. Services provided in Pasco and Pinellas.



Sarasota & Pinellas Rapid Rehousing Collaborative

Provides case management and rental assistance to those individuals and families who are staying in emergency shelters or on the street with no other resources.

- Intake & Housing Search Inventory
- Housing Identification
- Move-In
- Case Management with wrap around services



Outreach

- CoC collaboration critical
- Coordinated Entry
- Emergency Stabilization



Intake

- Paperwork readiness (funder driven)
- Program orientation / expectations



Housing Inventory & Search

- Location, location, location
- Rent reasonableness
- True Budgeting



Housing Identification

- Landlord Negotiations
- Lease education



Move In

- Services begin in home
- Self-determined rules & regulations
- Greatly celebrated!



Case Management

- Wrap around services:
 - Resource Improvement
 - Financial, social, support system
 - Mental health (if applicable and requested)
 - Physical health (if applicable and requested)
- Quarterly Move-in Celebrations
